Dear Municipal Clerk:

The January 1, 2021 final population estimate for the City of Hartford in Washington County is 16,076.

Approximately 11,989 of the estimated population for the City of Hartford in Washington County are of voting age. This approximation is a courtesy estimate that helps you comply with Wisconsin Statute 5.66, which requires municipal clerks to approximate the number of electors prior to elections. The voting age population was calculated by applying the 2010 Census proportion of persons age 18 and over to the final January 1 estimate, and then multiplying the result by a state-wide factor to account for the general aging of the population. Please note that, if you have an adult correctional facility in your municipality, its population is included in this voting-age estimate.

Wisconsin's Department of Administration is required to develop and disseminate preliminary population estimates by August 10 each year. Due to COVID delays, the U.S. Census Bureau did not release municipal Census 2020 data until August 12, 2021. For this reason, the DOA's 2021 population estimates were largely based on Census 2010 data.

DOA population estimates do not have statutory authority or enough detail for redistricting tasks. Wisconsin's Legislative Technology Services Bureau posted redistricting data at <https://legis.wisconsin.gov/ltsb/gis/data/>.
